Overview

Want to be the very best in hospitality management? Looking to start a rewarding, lifelong career? This is the course for you.

Over three years, you'll become equipped with all the skills you need to stand out and succeed in a highly competitive and constantly evolving environment.

You'll develop high-calibre professional competencies and an exceptional knowledge of hotel, tourism and travel management. You'll also have a strong theoretical and practical framework that opens the door to roles requiring creativity, knowledge, critical thinking, problem-identification and problem-solving.

Enter the BBA with our English as a Foreign Language (EFL) programme

Our BBA requires an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test score of 5.5 or equivalent. If you don't have this score already, we offer an EFL course that can get you to that level so you can enter the programme. Each EFL course is three months (one trimester) in length and aims to increase your IELTS score by approximately 0.5.

The BBA programme includes a six-month internship with a premier hospitality brand. Personalised learning




Shop 'til you drop

Three steps to success

We've made the application process as simple and straightforward as we can – and you can do it all online in around 25 minutes.



1. Fill out the online application at emiratesacademy.edu

We'll need a certain amount of personal information, some of it mandatory. The more details you're able to give us, the easier we can make the enrolment process.

2. Add the required documents

You'll need to upload:

- Your **high school transcripts** showing the final grades from the last three years you completed and your diploma
- A **colour copy of your passport**, which we use to apply for your visa
- A **passport-sized photo with a white background**
- A **medical information form** so we're aware of any medical conditions
- Your **English proficiency test**, showing either official TOEFL/IELTS test results or registration confirmation

3. Pay the application fee

This covers all the administrative costs of creating your file and reviewing your application.
